Over to AGWEB, snow plagues Canadian farmers in the heat of the harvest, this is September 13th. Even in the article it's quoted from farmers, "it's exceptional the amount".

Snow Plagues Canadian Farmers In The Heat Of Harvest



Canada farmers received an early snow this season.

"It's not unheard of for us to get snow during harvest, but it's exceptional to get this amount." says Jerome Isaac, who grows hard red spring wheat, canola and yellow field pears in Alberta, Canada. "Yesterday we got about six inches of snow and it hasn't melted."

Keep in mind that wasn't even officially the start of fall, it was still officially summer when this happened. This is how much snow came down September 12th.






With the intensification of the Grand Solar Minimum, you would expect to have shorter growing seasons with early snows that will affect the crops, and yields coming out of the fields.

The shift of our global weather patterns are set to amplify 2x from July-Dec 2017, and from 2018-2019 a 4x shift, with another jump up as the spread widens to 6x in 2019. (I explain this in detail on pages 38-41)



Orange arrow, this is where we are we're moving to the right through 2019, 2020, and 2021. All the exceptional crazy weather that you have seen over this last year or year and a half is that small little rise from 2017 to present, we are going to see some gargantuan changes through 2019 and 2020. 
With headlines like this off IceAgeNow.info, Robert Felix's site, October 2nd this is in Calgary, Canada was the snowiest day on record. I realize the old record was only 5 centimeters, but this new record-breaking snow was 25 centimeters.

Not just for the day, but for the entire month of October.

2 Oct 2018 – A record-breaking 15 to 25 cm of snow fell in Calgary overnight, said CBC meteorologist Christy Climenhaga. The previous record for Oct. 2 was set in 1954 with only about five cm.

"But the all-time extreme record for one day in October is about 30 centimetres (12 inches) in 1914, so you guys are on your way to breaking that," said Climenhaga.


A glimpse into Alberta here, famous tar sands oil production in Fort McMurray / Grand Prairie, Edmonton, Calgary blanketed.
